Stéphane Paquin (PhD, Institut d'Études politiques de Paris) is full professor at the École nationale d'administration publique (ENAP), where he is the holder of the Canada Research Chair in International and Comparative Political Economy (CRÉPIC). He is also scientific director at ENAP's Observatoire de l'administration publique, editor-in-chief of the journal *Télescope*, and co-editor of the "Politique mondiale" collection published by the Presses de l'Université de Montréal. He is the chair of the local organizing committee of the World Congress of Political Science, to be held in Montreal in 2014.

Stéphane Paquin was previously an associate professor at the Université de Sherbrooke's school of applied politics, visiting predoctoral fellow at Northwestern University's political science department, lecturer at the Institut d'Études politiques de Paris, guest professor at the Université de Montréal's political science department, visiting professor at the Université du Québec à Montréal (UQAM), assistant to the holder of the Chaire Hector-Fabre d'histoire du Québec (Hector Fabre chair of Quebec history (UQAM), and interim director general of the International Political Science Association (IPSA).

He has authored or coauthored eight books, including *International Policy and Politics in Canada* (Toronto, Pearson Canada, 2010) and *Politique internationale et défense au Canada et au Québec* (Montreal, Presses de l'Université de Montréal, 2007), with Kim Richard Nossal and Stéphane Roussel; *Économie politique internationale* (2nd ed., Paris, Montchrestien, 2009); *La nouvelle économie politique internationale. Théories et enjeux* (Paris, Armand Colin, 2008); *Paradiplomatie et relations internationales* (Brussels, Presses interuniversitaires européennes, 2004).

He has coedited nine books, including *Analyse des politiques publiques* (Montreal, Presses de l'Université de Montréal, 2010), with Luc Bernier and Guy Lachapelle; the prize-winning *Introduction aux relations internationales* (Montreal, Chenelière Éducation, 2009), with Dany Deschênes; and *Mastering Globalization: New Sub-States' Governance and Strategies* (London, Routledge, 2005), with Guy Lachapelle.

In addition to being the recipient of numerous scholarships (Fulbright, SSHRC, FQRSC, PIERAN), he has published upwards of 50 articles, including several that have appeared in academic journals such as *The Hague Journal of Diplomacy*, *Nationalism & Ethnic Politics*, *Canadian Journal of Political Science/Revue canadienne de science politique*, *Études internationales*, *Canadian Public Administration/Administration publique du Canada*, *Revue internationale de politique comparée* and *Guerres mondiales et conflits contemporains*.

In 2008, Mr. Paquin was selected to participate in the US government's prestigious International Visitor Leadership Program. He is also an accredited ambassador of the Palais des Congrès de Montréal (Montreal convention centre).
